Improvement projects



We met with the local authorities at the end of October to present our development ideas. We received positive feedback on several projects, including the renovation of the clubhouse (kitchen and indoor/outdoor furniture) and the opening of the hall, clubhouse and outdoor courts with a badge or smartphone system. This project will be developed over the coming months, in close collaboration with the commune. Another project involves the

installation of a fixed cover over the outdoor benches, as is done in sunnier regions; this is because the current sun umbrella system is unsatisfactory.

Several other projects will be studied later, such as access for members in wheelchairs or with disabilities, or a footbridge at the rear of courts 2 and 3 to enable spectators to watch matches during interclubs and tournaments.

In addition, we are currently investigating the possibility of covering courts 5 and 6 with a winter structure. This type of project is nothing new, as other committees at other times have already proposed this kind of development. However, current technologies could enable us to develop a project that considers the required energy and environmental factors to convince the municipal authorities.
